**New Music Festival Rolls onto the Scene in Stewart County**

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE - DOVER, TN --- There's a new summer music festival on the scene and it's headed for Stewart County. RRoll Over Dover will roll into town Labor Day weekend, 2008, with three days of blues, bluegrass, folk and rock.

Forty bands and numerous artisan vendors will converge on a 200 acre farm nestled in beautiful Land Between the Lakes during the RRoll Over Dover Music and Arts Festival.

The current lineup includes international bluegrass superstar Rhonda Vincent, world's greatest party band Buckwheat Zydeco, and up-and-coming rocker Toby the Fugitive. Artists continue to be added regularly.

RRoll Over Dover expects to draw around 10,000 music lovers in its first year and will require a lot of support to run smoothly. Festival organizer and Stewart County resident David Morgan intends to hire local help.

"There are a lot of national companies that specialize in big festivals like this," said Morgan. "But why would I contract out with them when there's plenty of people who could use the work right here at home?"

RRoll Over Dover Music & Arts Festival is dedicated to celebrating musicians and music lovers with three days of affordable camping and live performance.
